The multiple and sub-districts, may have their official notices, directives, memorandums, etc., to all concerned posted in hard copies in the "COMMUNICATION WINDOW" for the clubs and their cabinet members to see and down load as an original copy. **No more** postal stamps nor expensive courier service.

Announcements and other short notes, upcoming events, commendations, etc., maybe posted in each "NOTICE & ANNOUNCEMENT BOARDS" of the multiple and each sub district in the space provided.

Aside from general information and few photo spaces about the respective club, Lions and Leos on the other hand will also have "Notice and Announcement Boards" for their members and guests to see and appreciate.

For communications between clubs or districts, vice-versa, particularly addressed to one destination, e.g. statement of accounts or what have you, hard copies maybe sent directly to the concerned as an email attachment and be received without delay as if we are next door in one roof.

Pretty soon we shall be able to arrange for a system for club's MMR to be officially reported to the respective district offices at a stroke of a finger.

This "lions-301.org" web site may also be utilized as a means to promote the many programs of our organization, even our own multiple and sub-district conventions, cabinet meetings and many other lions' activities, even seminar materials. The advantages are endless and all we got to do is make use of it.

Let me also ask you to fill up the "Enrollment Form" found elsewhere thereat then click the send button.
